Elizabeth Marie "Betsy" Vann Adkins departed this life on September 1, 2020. Born December 16, 1956, to James Earl and Martha Curlee Vann on Cherry Point, Betsy's life was destined to be great from the start. Upon his discharge from the US Marine Corps, and subsequent move to Clinton, NC, the Vanns made their home in Clinton. Betsy remained in Clinton, NC, until her acceptance to Saint Mary's College in Raleigh, NC, where she finished high school and completed an associate's degree.

Betsy's life was fulfilled upon the arrival of her daughter, DeLana Adkins, in 1984 and son, Vann Adkins, in 1987. She moved to Wilmington in March of 1988 and remained there until her passing.

Betsy truly touched every person that she met and left a lasting impression on everyone. She is predeceased by her father, Dr. James Earl Vann, and her sister, Martha Morgan "Marty" Vann. She is survived by her mother, Martha Curlee Vann, her daughter DeLana (Casey) Adkins, her son Vann (Jessica) Adkins, her sister, Ida Perry (John) Schafer, granddaughter Cameron Edwards, and multiple cousins, nieces and nephews, and friends that she treasured as though they were family.
