



Johannes "John" Marinus Mostard

July 8, 1939 - December 1, 2019

Johannes "Joop" Marinus Mostard, 80, of Wilmington, NC, passed away quietly at home on December 1, 2019, surrounded by his family.

He was born July 8, 1939 in Den Haag, the Netherlands, to the late Johannes Marinus Mostard and Adrianna Johanna Buitendijk. Johannes was also preceded in death by a grandson, Job Mostard.

He is survived by his loving wife of 51 years, Joyce. He is also survived by their 3 children: Monique Mostard, Sandra Mostard, Brian Mostard (and his spouse Jenifer); his sister Jannie Mostard of Lelystad, Netherlands; and 6 grandchildren: JD, Kaitlynn, Jaclyn, John, Bianca and Ezra Mostard.

Johannes served two years in the Dutch Royal Airforce and was stationed in Dutch New Guinea. He returned to Holland in 1962 and was employed by Lindeteves Jacoberg as an accountant to work in Monrovia, Liberia, where he met his wife Joyce Loreen Bishop of Pittsburgh, PA on the BF Goodrich Rubber Plantation in 1968. They were married in Franklin Park, PA on September 21, 1968. Joop worked on the coast of West Africa for almost 50 years before he retired from his position as the Chief Accounting Officer for the Lababidi Corporation in Lagos, Nigeria in 2011, when moved to the US to be with his family. He spent his retirement playing bridge, discussing politics, and enjoying watching his grandchildren grow.
