



Marshall Charles Mansolillo, II

March 4, 1941 - January 28, 2023

On Saturday, January 28, 2023, Marshall “Marsh” Charles Mansolillo II died at age 81, signing off on a life that was well lived. God broke the mold after Marsh was born to the late Alfred and Lee Mansolillo on March 4, 1941 in Poughkeepsie, New York. He was a proud graduate of Union College in 1963 and class of ‘66 at Syracuse University. He was a tenacious and resolute Chemical Salesman for most of his career, and his unabashed frugality earned him a nice living. He Married Tracey Dragon Mansolillo in 1969 and raised two daughters, Marcey and Meredith, and a son, Marshall.

Marsh lived with an adventurous spirit and enjoyed sailing, tennis, boating, hunting and traveled most of the world. He was proud of his athleticism and would often brag about his rugby and football days; Marsh was not short on self-assurance. He was intelligent and possessed a wealth of knowledge gleaned from a love of history and avid reading. Marsh also loved a good prank, as any of his old friends will attest. He and Tracey enjoyed a rich life traveling, spending time laughing with friends, playing tennis together and were known to “cut a rug”. His children were well loved and protected; provided with a good education and always a word of wisdom - solicited or not. Upon retirement Marsh would often utter the phrase, “Life is Good,” while making an OK gesture with one hand and holding a cigar in the other. A good life he had indeed.

Marsh is preceded in death by his mother and father, Lee and Alfred; his sister, Tina and his son Marshall. He is survived by his wife, Tracey, and his

daughters, Marcey and Meredith and grandson, Quinn. A funeral service and celebration of his life will be held on February 14, 2023 at Saint Therese Catholic Church, 209 S.
